# Beach Lifeguards



- Essential qualifications
  - Possess Surf Life Saving Australia (SLSA) Bronze Medallion
  - Possess all relevant qualifications and the ability to obtain an SLSA Gold Medallion
  - A current First Aid Certificate
  - Advanced Resuscitation Certificate
  - Lifeguarding/Lifesaving patrol experience
  - Demonstrated ability to work unsupervised
  - Proven ability to communicate effectively with staff and the public
  - Demonstrate an ability to work in a team situation

- Programs include
  - Resuscitate a Mate
  - Boating Safety Education
  - Open Water Learning
  - Beach Programs
- Essential qualifications
  - Senior First Aid (Level 2)
  - Plus one of
    - Pool Lifeguard or
    - Bronze Medallion (pool or beach) or
    - AUSTSWIM



# Community Training & Assessing

- Including commercial courses such as
  - Community Surf Lifesaving Certificate
  - SLSA Bronze Medallion
  - SLSA Surf Rescue Certificate
  - First Aid and CPR
- Qualifications
  - Vary with position
