Subject: Extended Flight Paths – Lifesaver 7 and Lifesaver 8

Action:

Further to the previous announcement on the expansion of the Westpac Lifesaver Aerial Service, I would like clubs to be aware of the following scheduled flights to the Far East and Far West regions.

As always, the aircraft can travel beyond their regular daily flight paths at any time should an incident require aerial support. Communication is via Life Saving Victoria Communications.

The aircraft will spend a short time conducting surveillance in the area of each club en route to the listed final destination, and land at at least one location in the region prior to its return.

Clubs are encouraged to promote the visits to their membership and local media, and once arrangements are finalised as to 'on ground time' at airports clubs will be notified. Please contact Greg Scott (details below) for any special requests regarding these visits.

- Sunday 25 March – Lakes Entrance (EAST)
