WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECKS

In line with Life Saving Victoria's Member Protection Policy 6.5, all Officials, Water Safety Personnel & Power Craft Duty Boat Crews MUST have a working with Children Check. WWCC cards must be sighted when you sign in for the day.

OFFICIALS & WATER SAFETY

Clubs please remember to provide your quota of water safety personnel and officials for the carnivals. Water safety personnel must hold a current SRC or Bronze Medallion qualification.

Officials should have a minimum qualification of level 1. However officials that have attended a level 1 course and are still in training are also very welcome to officiate at the carnival. These officials should be getting their log books signed off by the carnival referee at the end of the day.

Clubs are welcome to put forward officials that are not accredited and have not yet attended a level 1 course. However these individuals will need to be under supervision of an accredited official and must attend the next available level 1 officials course.

AGE GROUP REFEREES

These people are in charge of their designated age group. When they collect their age group box at the start of the day they will be required to sign a register. This person will be responsible for the equipment in the box and to return the box with all equipment accounted for.

SUN PROTECTION

All clubs will be responsible for Sun Protection for their competitors. Please refer to LSV Sun Safety Policy 2.1.

PROGRAM
