Subject: Assessment Resource Development Sessions (ARDS) – 07/08 Proficiency Resources

As introduced at the State Training and Assessment Plenary session, monthly sessions are now being conducted that will focus on the development of assessment resources, known as Assessment Resource Development Sessions (ARDS). The aim of ARDS is to “*Investigate and provide recommendations for amendments and improvements to assessment resources*”.

ARDS will work towards producing high quality products, using the most up-to-date evidence available. The resources will be developed with the help of specialists in the field, and feedback from users of the resources. ARDS will run for 1.5 hrs and is aimed at anyone interested in improving assessment within Life Saving Victoria.

The first ARDS looked at the development of **Validation and Feedback Resources**. This session was extremely successful and provided the input needed to move Validation and Feedback Resources into their present production. These resources will be released by the end of February 2007.
