**Subject:** Training Resource Development Sessions (TRDS) – Scenario Based Training and Wounds Makeup

As introduced at the State Training and Assessment Plenary session, monthly sessions are now being conducted that will focus on the development of training resources, known as Training Resource Development Sessions (TRDS). The aim of TRDS is to *“Investigate and provide recommendations for amendments and improvements to training resources and ideas and to work closely with the Assessment Resource Development Sessions”*.

TRDS will work towards producing high quality products, using the most up-to-date evidence available. The resources will be developed with the help of specialists in the field, and feedback from users of the resources. TRDS will run for 1.5 hrs and is aimed at anyone interested in improving training within Lifesaving Victoria.

The first TRDS will focus on ideas and strategies for **scenario based training** for the 2007-2008 season. This session will also focus on some simple make-up techniques to create wounds like those seen below and will be held:
