Club Championships Point Score

The Aquatic Sports Executive and Officials Panel have decided to introduce a new structure to the Club Championship Point Scoring system. This new structure will introduce more lifesaving events in awarding the overall Victorian Club Champion of the Year.

This Point scoring will commence at the Victorian Masters Championships and finish at the Victorian Pool Lifesaving Championships in August 2010.

Events to be included in the Club Championships Point Score

- Victorian Masters Championships
- Victorian Lifesaving Championships (Juniors & Seniors)
- Victorian IRB Championships
- Victorian Pool Lifesaving Championships (Seniors)

At each Championship, points will be graded from the number of clubs in Victoria (57), with 1st = 57 points, 2nd = 56 point and so on down to 57th = 1 point. Points will be allocated in each event only to those clubs participating, the maximum points will remain 57 regardless of the number of participating clubs and the minimum in any one event will vary due to club numbers.

At the completion of the season, all Championship Points will be tallied and the overall leading club of the year will be awarded the title of Victorian Club Champion of the Year.
