The 2010 Victorian Pool Lifesaving Competition will continue to run along last year's new structure, with the new look and feel of competitions and training preparing athletes for selection into the future State Teams.

LSV once again will run events at Wyndham, King Club and finish the season at MSAC, where the Senior Victorian Pool Lifesaving Championships will be held.

The 'DASH FOR CASH' event will be conducted for senior competitors only, with competitors able to compete against each other to win prize money in the Open Freestyle events.

Also Victorian Nippers, who may aspire to State Team members & Australian representatives in the future, are encouraged to attend the junior events this winter to build their lifesaving skills in fun and inclusive events.

Club Championship Point Score

This season sees the inclusion of a new Club Championship Point Score, with the club having the highest overall point score from all State Championship events become the Victorian Club Champion of the Year.

This Point scoring will commence at the Victorian Masters Championships and finish at the Victorian Pool Lifesaving Championships in August 2010.
