The 2010 Telstra Assistance Fund is a subsidy program that helps to supply our frontline lifesavers with the essential equipment they need to conduct their lifesaving duties.

The fund consists of \$275,000 nationally (excluding GST), which is distributed to clubs throughout Australia.

Clubs who do not have sufficient compatible radio handsets as per [Circular 058:05:10](#), are strongly encouraged to make application for new units under the Telstra Assistance Fund. For radios applications this is a 100% funded grant and applications for radios by such clubs will be given highest priority.

Applications are now open, and close Friday, 4 June 2010.
