- able to work independently, or as part of a team
- able to demonstrate innovative thinking and take a proactive approach
- skilled in communication and have highly developed interpersonal skills, including the ability to liaise and consult with people at all levels, including camp participants, other facilitators and external stakeholders
- a holder of a current Working With Children Check (volunteer)

Application Process

- Interested candidates should fill in and return the "2009 Leadership Opportunity - Application Form" (attached) to Drew Urlichs at LSV by Friday, 26 December 2008. If sent on or within a few days of one of the public holidays, please ensure it has a post mark date prior to 26 December 2008.
- LSV will short-list applicants and contact those successful at obtaining an interview by Friday, 2 January 2009.
- Short-listed applicants will attend an interview on Tuesday, 6 February 2009.
- Successful applicants will be informed of their selection by Friday, 9 February 2009.
