A1 Time, Date and Location

Date: Saturday, 11 February 2012
Location: Lorne SLSC
Registration: 7:30 am
Start time: 8:00 am (See link to view Program times)

A2 Entries (Online Only)

All competitors must be current financial and proficient members of Life Saving Victoria (LSV). Entries for Clubs will be based on the normal season entries by using the online entry system. All team Managers are responsible for entering competitors into events and will be required to enter members electronically through the LSV website under the Sports main menu and by clicking the registrations link on the main page. Team Managers must obtain a username and password from the Aquatic Sports Department on 03 9676 6957 or by emailing sport@lifesavingvictoria.com.au. Interstate competitors wishing to compete must obtain a clearance form from their state branch and submit it to the Aquatic Sports Department.

A2 Registrations

Registration will take place from 7:30 am at the LSV Administration Tent on the grassed area east of the club.

For this year's Championships, ONLY Team managers are required to come to registrations to register competitors that are a LATE ENTRY. All other competitors should have been registered by the cut off time of Thursday midnight before the event.

This season ALL competitors are asked to write their own age group number on their arm for the age group they will be competing in for the duration of the competition.

In individual events where two (2) or less starters are prepared to contest an event, those competitors may contest a lower age group in that event, without prejudice to their age category in other events.

****Competitors will be able to write their own numbers on their arm prior to the start of registration to assist administration personnel and speed up the registration process.***

A3 Entry Fees

Competitor entry in the 2012 Victoria Masters Championships is \$32.00 per competitor (GST inc). Clubs will be invoiced following the competition for the total amount of competitors, including team lists.

Late entries will be taken on the day and charged twice the competitor entry fee i.e. $2 \times \$32 = \64.00 . These individuals will have to prove they are financial and supply a copy of their patrol hours. ***Cash payment only is accepted on the day.***

Competitors will not be able to compete if they have not registered. If found competing without being registered, late fee penalties of four (4) times the entry fee will apply i.e. $4 \times \$32 = \128.00

A4 Medals

Medals will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd & 3rd placegetters.

Please note that medals will be awarded on the basis of two (2) starters for Gold only, three (3) starters for Gold & Silver and four (4) starters for Gold, Silver & Bronze.

For an event to run, it must have a minimum of two (2) competitors to start.

The races in each area will start with the oldest age group first.

****After the completion of each event, medals will be handed out in the presentation area in your area.***

A5 Officials Requirements

This year there has been a change to the structure of the ratio of Officials per Competitor.

Clubs must provide one (1) Official for 5-9 competitors, two (2) Officials for 10-19 competitors, three (3) Officials for 20-29 competitors and so on.

If Clubs fail to supply Officials according to the ratios given above, the clubs athletes will not be allowed to compete until the above requirements are met.

Please note, team managers will be required to enter officials via the online carnival entries system as per the ratios provided above. They are to enter the officials details as per competitor, but also enter "000" code into the events area under the officials name. Officials will not be invoiced for the day's competition. Water Safety can be entered in as "555" and Powercraft personnel as "444" in the same manor. These will not be charged on the entry team list.



A6 Powercraft Requirements

For the 2012 Victorian Masters Championships clubs will be notified individually on their requirements for the championships by Chief Referee Harry Hannas.
