## Section A Championship Dates & Venues

2012 Victorian Lifesaver Event Championships (First Aid, Patrol Competition & Champion Lifesaver events) will be held on the following days:

## Section B Championship Entry Information

### B1 Entry information

All competitors must be current financial and proficient members of Life Saving Victoria to enter events.

#### On-line Entries

Team managers will be required to enter members electronically through the LSV website ([www.registration.lifesavingvictoria.com.au](http://www.registration.lifesavingvictoria.com.au)).

Team Managers **only** must obtain a username and password from the Manager Aquatic Sports on 03 9676 6957 or email [drew.urlichs@lifesavingvictoria.com.au](mailto:drew.urlichs@lifesavingvictoria.com.au)

**Note** - Please read the instructions posted on the website on how to use the system.

#### Close of Entries

Entries are to be completed no later than 11:59PM on Thursday, 16 February 2012.

**Please note** - The system has a timed cut off, entries must be submitted before 11:59PM. Team managers will have the ability to make changes to the carnival entries on the day of competition until 10:00 AM.

**Please ensure** that all athletes are entered into specific events using codes listed in Section C of this circular.

Upon completion of the above, the following will be undertaken by Life Saving Victoria:

- Entries will be checked for eligibility, Patrol Hours & Proficiency
- Clubs will be invoiced for entry fees following the event. As this is a championship event all competitors will be charged \$32.00 (GST inc) each. This includes all 3 days of competition.

### B2 Proficiency & Patrol Hour Requirements

The details of these requirements are set out in the SLSA Policy No. 5.4 – Patrol Hour Requirements (<http://www.slsa.com.au/default.aspx?s=adminresources&id=44>).

Notwithstanding the foregoing, Life Saving Victoria reserves the right to conduct a random or detailed audit of entries and under such circumstances, the selected clubs will be required to submit appropriate documentation to substantiate the eligibility of those members entered.

### B3 Entry Fees

Entry fees for the 2012 Victorian Lifesaving Championships are \$32.00 per competitor. As this event is part of the Victorian Lifesaving Championships any athlete entered into the Senior Championships at Anglesea will **not** be charged for both events.

Any competitor found competing without being registered, will be charged (4) four times the entry fee.

## **C2 Champion Lifesaver**

The three sections that comprise the Champion Lifesaver event and allocated maximum points are:

### **Competition Events - 40 points**

- Surf Race
- Board Race
- Beach Sprint
- Rescue Tube Race

### **Questionnaire - 40 points**

- 40 Multiple Choice questions derived from the current SLSA Training Manual

### **Resuscitation - 40 points**

Competitors should refer to the SLSA Surf Sports Manual (33<sup>rd</sup> Edition) for amendments to this section.

## **C3 Patrol Competition**

The patrol competition is divided into 4 basic sections:

### **Physical Skills - 20 points**

- Run-Swim-Run teams
- Board Tube rescue relay race

### **Theory - 20 points**

- 40 Multiple Choice questions derived from the current SLSA training manual

### **Resuscitation - 20 points**

Competitors should refer to the SLSA Surf Sports Manual (33<sup>rd</sup> Edition) for amendments to this section.
